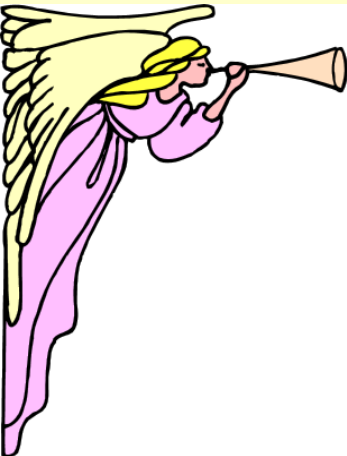

FROM THE PASTOR



Is there something bothering you...

I would like to share some thoughts on worship with you that I experienced recently.

After a long and trying day, it was 7:00 PM and

Wednesday evening worship was just beginning. It was

difficult for me to get into a worshipful mood with everything that was on my mind and heart that day. After the "welcome" at the beginning of the worship service and the introduction to of the sermon I sat down to begin the first hymn.

The first hymn happened to be from our praise book. It was number 61. As the tune started to fill our sanctuary I started to sing the words. Because of the things on my mind I thought I would just be going through the motions. But then the words of the praise song began to sink in as I sang them.

These were the words of the praise song that night in worship:

When the morning falls on the farthest hill I will sing His name, I will praise Him, still. When dark trials come and my heart is filled with the weight of doubt, I will praise Him, still. For the Lord, our God, He is strong to save from the arms of death, from the deepest grave; And he gave us life in His perfect will, and by His good grace I will praise Him, still.

After singing these words twice through, I felt the weight lifted from my heart even though I still had the issues to deal with, it

was okay. These words reminded me that even though we may face the trials and tribulations of this world, we have the Lord God at our side. He may not take away the challenges we face but He promises to help us endure whatever we will face.

No matter what, we still praise our Lord for He is our every-present help in time of trouble. No matter what, we still praise Him for He is our Creator and Redeemer. No matter what, we still praise Him for He is our Rock and our Salvation. No matter what, He will work out all things for our ultimate benefit.

No matter what, we still praise Him!

As the song came to an end I thought for a minute about those people who miss out on worship. I thought do they know what they are missing. I thought they should be in worship, too, and praise Him, still, no matter what.

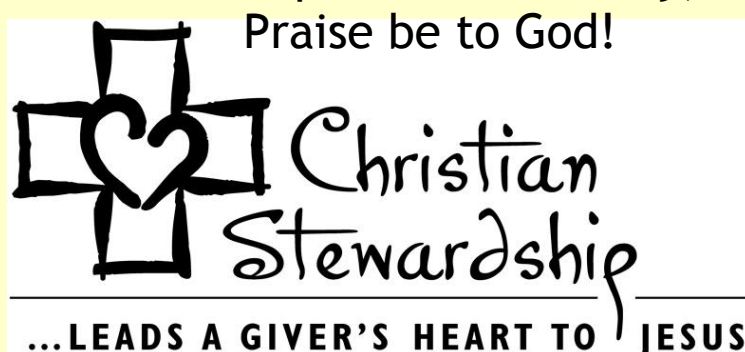
As we celebrate another Consecration Sunday on November 14 may we prayerfully meditate on these words from God:

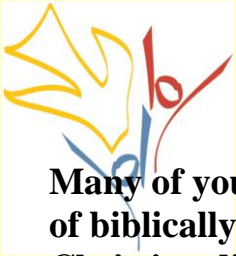
- “Each man should give what he had decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.” II Corinthians 9:7

- “The people rejoiced at the willing response...for they had given freely and wholeheartedly to the Lord.” I Chronicles 29:9
- “This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of God’s people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God.” II Corinthians 9:12
- “From what you have, take an offering for the Lord. Everyone who is willing is to bring to the Lord an offering...” Exodus 35:5
- “The silver is mine and the gold is mine, declares the Lord Almighty.” Haggai 2:8
- “The earth is the Lord’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it.” Psalm 24:1

CS4: The Journey Continues

Consecration Sunday is November 14, 2010

Many of you will remember our *Consecrated Stewards* emphasis of last year. It was a time of biblically based stewardship education and commitment that helped to raise people in Christian discipleship and saw our people grow in their stewardship commitment in a way that has enabled us to move forward in mission and ministry.

This year the *Consecrated Stewards* emphasis takes a new shape with “**CS4: THE JOURNEY CONTINUES.**” November 14 will be “Consecration Sunday,” the culmination of a four week journey exploring the joys of being a partner with God in His mission to the world. Mark that date on your calendar as a time of spiritual growth, fellowship, and commitment here at St John’s.

Consecrated Stewards helps grow people; not just raise money. The call to commitment is based on the biblical philosophy of the need of the giver to give in joyful response to God’s grace, rather than on the need of the church to receive. It is not based on the budgetary needs of the church, but on the desire to have each person grow in discipleship. Opportunity for growth in discipleship will take place during the Sundays October 24 through November 14.

- The personal witness of some of our members.
- Encouragement and resources for prayer.
- Celebration of the various ministries of our congregation.
- A series of Bible studies.
- Consecration Sunday activities on November 14, including:
 - Reverend Jon Lieder will be our guest proclaimer.
 - A special fellowship and Celebration Luncheon for all the St. John’s family.
 - Opportunity to make a faith-based commitment during the worship service.

The encouragement to commitment on Consecration Sunday takes place within the context of the morning worship service. Our Guest Leader will conduct a brief period of instruction and inspiration, and then ask our attendees and members to respond to God’s leading through a financial commitment that represents a step forward in grace-motivated giving.

Every attendee and member who completes a response card does so voluntarily by attending morning worship on Consecration Sunday. We also urge people to attend who feel strongly opposed to completing a card. The procedure is done in such a way that no one feels personal embarrassment if he or she chooses not to fill out a card. *Consecrated Stewards* works with people where they are and when they are ready. Members make their commitments as a confidential act of worship.

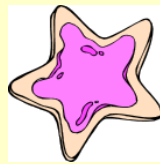
We will do no home solicitation to ask people to complete cards. Since we will make no follow-up visits to ask people to complete their cards, we will make every effort to inform,

Classes will resume on January 9th.

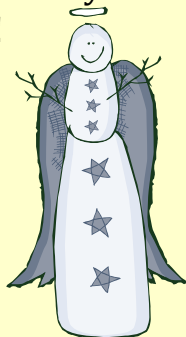

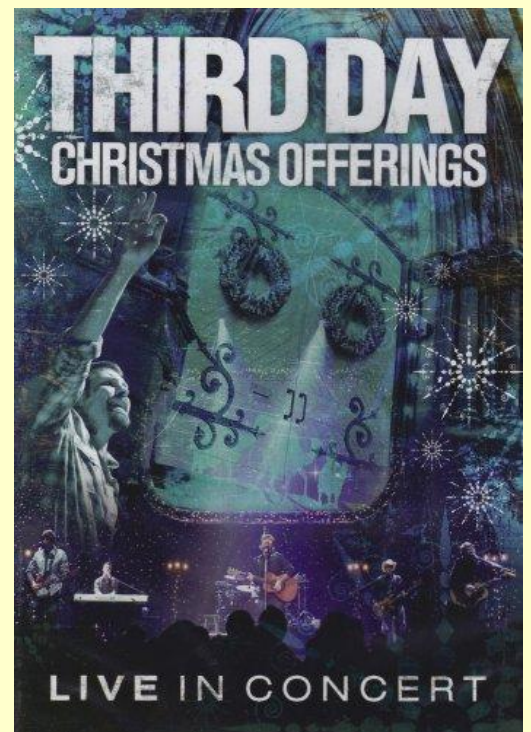
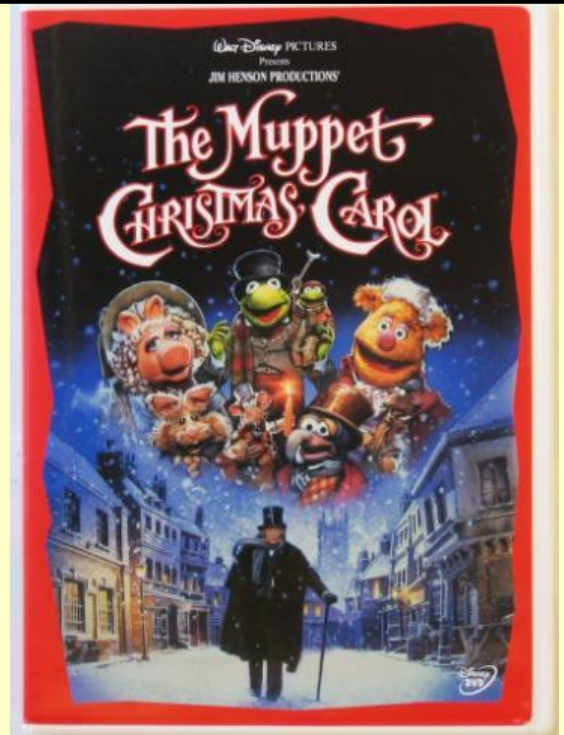
WHEN I SAY THAT 'I AM A CHRISTIAN'

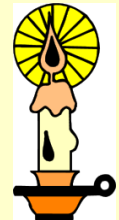
